Welcome to the Agora Bushwalk

The Bushwalk includes Kells Road Bushland and Benenden Bushland. As you explore the trail, you can find more information by scanning the NFC tags or QR codes using an enabled device, or visiting www.agorabushwalk.com.

The Agora Bushwalk is an important link between the beach and the bush. It forms a corridor for wildlife moving between coastal bushland and Neerabup National Park.

The Bushwalk is a great resource for people too. Along the way you will find gently undulating terrain, wildlife, exercise equipment, playgrounds, shops, wifi and quiet places to sit and enjoy the bush.

Protecting your Bushland

Protect your bushland by keeping to the paths. Weeds and garden plants can invade bushland. Please mulch your garden waste or save it for a council green waste pick up.

Please keep your dog on a lead and your cat at home. For the sake of other park users, please clean up after your pets and take your rubbish with you when you leave.
